The Course aims at promoting a culture of international cooperation among students, scholars and practitioners in the fields of urban design and management, by acquiring:

- The ability to understand the contexts and interact with people and organizations of the Global South
- The specific ability to share the search for solutions to face the challenges raised by radical socio-economic, environmental and cultural changes caused by globalisation, above all the rapid and massive urbanisation processes in Countries of the Global South, which raise dramatically new problems of spatial and social inequality, as well as a new and difficult environmental challenge related to the climate change.

The Course offers to new generation of experts the chance to acquire skills and knowledge that will help them to develop an integrated and multidisciplinary approach to planning, design and management of urban settlements and territories in contexts with a high level of social, economic, territorial, and landscape vulnerability.

ELEGIBILITY Students with at least a three-year university degree, individuals with Bachelor or Master of Science in Architecture, Engineering, Urban Planning, Design, Sociology, Anthropology, Geography, Economy and other scientific fields are eligible for this Course.

CREDITS AND CERTIFICATE The Course is equal to 15 University Credits (CFU). After passing the final examination at the end of the Course students will receive a Certificate of participation.

DURATION The Course will begin in October 2015 and end in October 2016. The lessons will be held once a week on Fridays (8 hours) for a total of 184 hours (23 days - approximately 7 months). Students could take part in suggested international projects or workshops also during summertime.

LANGUAGE The course will be taught in English, except for the evaluation of language skills of the participants admitted. Students must have in any case a good knowledge of English.

VENUE The Course will be held at Politecnico di Milano | Leonardo Campus

TUITION FEE € 1.200,00
The reduced fee of € 900,00 is applicable to PhD students, and graduates of less than 12 months (5 October 2014).
